March 23, 2026

Trustee Mark Morman called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
This was a regular meeting of the Village of Mackinaw.

III. CONSENT AGENDA: The consent agenda consists of approving March 9, 2026 regular meeting minutes, Police department report, Public Works department report, recurring disbursements, and finance packet.

Trustee Severt moved, seconded by Trustee Wilkins to approve the above-listed consent agenda items. On a roll call, the vote was:

IV. PUBLIC COMMENT:

V. DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

1. POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT: The Board reviewed the report submitted by the Police Chief.

2. PUBLIC WORKS MANAGER'S REPORT: Public Works Manager Mike Schopp reported on the activities of the department. Schopp will begin the water sample process to turn the water on at Brock Lake this week. The bid opening for MFT was last week, there was only one bid for the sealcoating maintenance project.

Approve Green View Turf Service for 2026 – Trustee Morman moved, seconded by Trustee Wilkins to approve the proposal from Green View for turf applications for Brock Lake diamonds at a cost of \$2,918.88, JFL football field at a cost of \$572.45, the soccer field at Westwood Park at a cost of \$734.11. This service is part of the Village's portion of the intergovernmental agreement with Mackinaw Township Recreation Group. On a roll call, the vote was:

Award 2026 MFT maintenance project – Trustee Morman moved, seconded by Trustee Severt to award the 2026 MFT maintenance project for sealcoating of various Village streets to R A Cullinan & Sons, Inc. at a proposed cost of \$135,674.71. On a roll call, the vote was:

There being four affirmative votes, the **motion carried.**

Purchase Mower – Trustee Morman moved, seconded by Trustee Kamp to authorize the purchase of a Hustler Super 260 fuel injected mower from Country Pet & Livestock Feeds at a cost of \$14,165.65. The Village will also trade in the 2022 Redmax mower at a value of \$5,000. This will leave a balance of \$9,165.65 for cost of the mower. Schopp will begin a 2 to 3 year cycle on trading in and purchasing a new mower for the department. On a roll call, the vote was:

Developer Agreement Guidelines – This item was tabled.

Intergovernmental Agreement with Tazewell County for community recycling grant – Trustee Wilkins moved, seconded by Trustee Severt to authorize Mayor Schmidgall to enter into a recycling agreement with Tazewell County for the Village to receive \$17,727.80. The Village agrees to register and implement the use of Recycle Coach (a web-based application for recycling information) and remain in compliance with the County’s IEPA approved Resource Recovery and Management Plan. On a roll call, the vote was:
